WHY IS WASTE MANAGEMENT AND PROPER HANDLING OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS IMPORTANT?

- Planning and implementing programs for waste reduction, reuse, donation, recycling, composting, and energy generation are important aspects of waste management
- The release of hazardous materials can impact water, air, and other environmental resources
