















- Even if you don't drive, roads still matter










Many key transportation facilities are 50 to 80 years old.





By 2020, close to 70 bridges are expected to become structurally deficient each year. Increased maintenance and preservation investments are necessary to keep these older facilities safe and operational.




#### **FUEL TAX INCREASE**





## DRIVERS WHO DON'T DRIVE A LOT, DON'T PAY A LOT.








All drivers pay their fair share for road use based on the true measure of miles driven versus gallons of fuel consumed.

### PROJECTED FUEL TAX REVENUE AND THE ANTICIPATED GAP.











